As provincial and Fraser Health directives continue to evolve throughout the pandemic, so does the way we deliver services at the clubhouse. Please see below a reminder of the current adaptations to our service, as well as updated COVID-19 guidelines:

Keeping our physical space safe for in-person services

The following protocols are in place to ensure the safety of all members and staff:

- Max of 16 participants per program inside the clubhouse
- Medical masks must be worn in the clubhouse at all times - If you have a cloth mask, we will provide a medical mask for replacement.
- Hand sanitising required upon entry to the clubhouse
- Temperature checks upon entry to the clubhouse
- Risk assessment questions answered upon entry to the clubhouse
- Regular hand washing/sanitising is encouraged.
- No food or drink consumption within the clubhouse

Providing a range of engagement options for clubhouse programs

- Scheduled appointments (in person or virtually)
